**Indirect objects** are nouns or pronouns that receive the action of the verb indirectly. They usually answer the questions "to whom" or "to what." If the indirect object is a pronoun, it must reflect the number and gender of the noun it replaces.

	<b>le (it)</b>	<b>les (them)</b>
