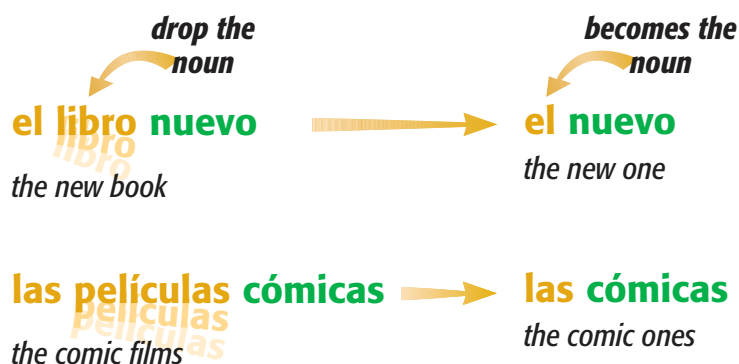

## Nominalization

If you want to avoid repeating the same word over again in a sentence, you can use **nominalization**.

You can **drop the noun** if it's used with an **adjective** and use just the **adjective** and **article** instead.



Me gusta **la camisa amarilla**. No me pondría **la roja**.

*I like the **yellow shirt**. I wouldn't wear the **red one**.*

You know that the **red one** is referring to the **red shirt**.

This structure also works with **indefinite articles**, **demonstrative adjectives**, and **numbers**.

No quiero un carro viejo. Quiero **uno nuevo**.

*I don't want an old car. I want **a new one**.*

Esas novelas realistas no son muy buenas. **Estas simbólicas** son mejores.

*Those realist novels aren't very good. **These symbolic ones** are better.*

Necesito cajas para enviar regalos. Quiero **tres cuadradas** y **dos redondas**.

*I need boxes to send gifts. I want **three square ones** and **two round ones**.*
