The Progressive with **ir**, **andar**, and **seguir**

**¿RECUERDAS?** p. 264 You already know that you use the **present progressive** tense to say what you are doing right now. You can also use the verbs **ir**, **andar**, and **seguir** instead of **estar** with the **present participle**.

Each of these verbs has a special meaning in progressive constructions.

**ir** + present participle

Anita **se va adaptando** a su puesto.

*Anita is (slowly but surely) adjusting to her job.*

**andar** + present participle

Isabel **anda buscando** trabajo.

*Isabel is going around looking for work.*

**seguir** + present participle

Isabel **sigue buscando** trabajo.

*Isabel is still looking for work.*
