## Subject and Stressed Object pronouns

Most of the time you do not use **subject pronouns** in Spanish, because the verb ending shows who the subject is. When you do include them it is because you wish to add emphasis, clarify, or make a contrast.

- to show emphasis

**Yo le di** las estadísticas,  
no Roberto.

*I gave him the statistics, not Roberto.*

- to make a comparison or clarify

**Él salió. Ella se quedó**  
en casa.

*He went out. She stayed home.*

You use the prepositional **a** + **subject pronouns** to clarify who the object of a preposition is, except in the case of **yo** and **tú**. Here **special object pronouns** are used (**mí, ti**).

El profesor les dio  
el reportaje **a ellos**.

*The teacher gave the report  
to them.*

No me lo dio **a mí**.

*He didn't give it to me.*
