Using the Verb *oír*

Like **hacer** and **conocer**, the verb **oír** (*to hear*) has an irregular **yo** form in the present tense.

- Some of its forms also require a spelling change where the **i** becomes a **y**.
- Note that the **nosotros(as)** and **vosotros(as)** forms have accents.

You may hear the expression **¡Oye!** used throughout the dialog. It is used to get someone's attention, the way *Hey!* is used in English.

To get Isabel's attention Ricardo might say: —**¡Oye**, Isabel!
