¿RECUERDAS?

p. 78 Do you remember the forms of the verb **tener**?

Venir (*to come*) is similar to **tener**, except that the **nosotros(as)** and **vosotros(as)** forms have **-ir** endings, while **tener** uses **-er** endings.

tengo	tenemos
tienes	tenéis
tiene	tienen

vengo	venimos
vienes	venís
viene	viene

Ignacio says:

—Roberto y su familia **viene**n a Puerto Rico...

Roberto and his family are coming to Puerto Rico...

Later he says:

—Yo **vengo** del cine.

I'm coming from the movie theater.
